

Documents to Send in with an Insurance Application

If you have income:

Proof of Income for everyone in the household that include:

Copies of pay stubs from each job for the last month

If you are paid in cash, you can ask your employer for a letter stating how much you make each pay period

If you are self-employed, a copy of your latest tax return

Copies of retirement income (not Social Security)

Monthly deposits of pensions or IRA income into a bank account Retirement income award letter

Copies of disability income (not Social Security)

Monthly deposits of disability income into a bank account Disability income award letter

Copies of unemployment income

Unemployment award letter

Bi-monthly deposits if unemployment income into a bank account

If you don't have income:

A letter from the person who supports you stating how they support you

Proof of Immigration

For each person applying for insurance, he/she will need a copy of one of these:

Permanent resident (green) card
Temporary I-551 stamp on passport or I-94, I-94A
Visa and passport
Employment Authorization Card (I-766)
Arrival/Departure Record (I-94/I-94A)
